
Thomas Struth: The New Retrospective Monograph

Thomas Struth: Photographs 1978-2010 (retail price € 58.-), published to accompany a major retrospective exhibition currently shown at Kunsthaus Zurich, presents a comprehensive survey of Struth's work of the last three decades. It features more than 330 works, many of which are hitherto unpublished. The Zurich exhibition runs until September 12, 2010, subsequently travelling to Dusseldorf, London, and Porto. Jeff Wall: The Master of Lucent Stagings in Dresden

Coinciding with the opening of the restructured Albertinum museum, the Dresden Kunsthalle presents "Transit", a major exhibition of the Canadian photo artist Jeff Wall, until September 19, 2010. The photo book *Transit* (retail price € 49.80), published by Schirmer/Mosel to complement the show, presents Wall's staged realities and his enigmatic sites in full-page illustrations. Parallel Processes: A Major Joseph Beuys Exhibition

Kunstsammlung Nordrhein-Westfalen is celebrating the artist, teacher, and political activist, Joseph Beuys, in a major exhibition (Sept 11, 2010 – Jan 16, 2011) that will be the hitherto most comprehensive evaluation of his great and manifold work. Anton Corbijn: The Making of The American

Anton Corbijn's publication on his new Hollywood film, *The American*, with no less than George Clooney in the starring role, is an illustrated book of superior quality (retail price € 39.80). During the shooting, director and master photographer Anton Corbijn took pictures almost daily. The candid images of his stars, all in color, provide a frank insight into the daily routines of shooting, with Corbijn commenting on them in a diary-like style.

Based on the novel *A Very Private Gentleman* by Martin Booth, the film will be shown at the **67th Venice International Film Festival** (September 2010). [German/English edition]



Yves Saint Laurent: Icons of Fashion Design

Yves Saint Laurent (1936–2008) was without doubt the most famous, most successful fashion designer of our times.
