Kate Winslet, Sofia Coppola, Nina Hoss and Reese Witherspoon, to name just a few of the 75 celebrated women, come across variously as mysterious, seductive, powerful, but also melancholy. Fashion, dance, nudes and portraits all feature, and even the occasional male can be encountered in Peter Lindbergh's female cosmos.

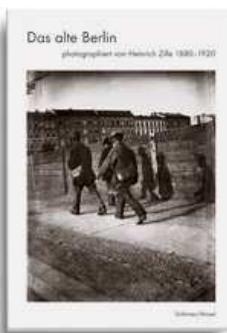

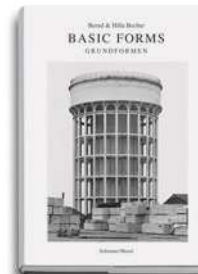

Anton Corbijn, John le Carré, Philip Seymour Hoffman and Hamburg

September 11 sees the German premiere the new film by Anton Corbijn: The thriller *A Most Wanted Man* is inspired by John le Carré's eponymous espionage novel. With its clear, atmospheric and raw images the book accompanying the film conveys an atmosphere between fiction and documentation, which Corbijn sensitively comments on with his own photographs and texts. The stars: the Hanseatic city of Hamburg and actor Philip Seymour Hoffman, who following his unexpected death in February 2014 is seen here in his next-to-last film.

The film will be premiered on July 22 in New York City.

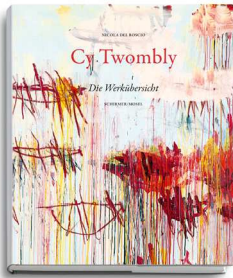

Drawings, paintings, sculptures, photographs – Cy Twombly: His oeuvre at a glance

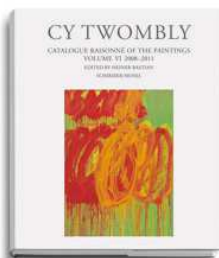

Cy Twombly: Die Werkübersicht

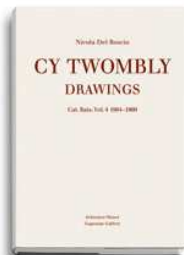
